

TLO SCHOOL MEAL PROGRAM

TLO School's meal program is administered by ISD 197 Child Nutrition.

What is the TLO School Meal Program?

Last year, legislation passed the Free School Meals bill into law. As such TLO students get one free breakfast and one free lunch. Details below.

Not included: A milk with home lunch or an extra milk. Price is \$0.60.

BREAKFAST

As a part of the Free School Meals law, all schools with a School Lunch Program are also required to offer a breakfast program.

Breakfast will be served from 7:00 -7:45 am each morning in the gym, free of charge to students. Students who are dropped off before 7:30 am for breakfast will be charged for Cub Club or BTB. If you would like to come and eat school breakfast with your child, please let the office know. An adult breakfast costs \$2.50.

Our breakfast menu will be on a two week rotating schedule to start. Breakfast will consist of grab and go items like cereal bars, muffins, cinnamon rolls, etc. with cheese stick or yogurt, fruit choice, and juice choice to complete the meal. Students will also be able to take a carton of milk with breakfast.

LUNCH

If you would like to come for lunch and eat hot lunch with your child, please let the office know in the morning. An adult lunch costs \$5.00.

Preschool lunch begins at 11:30 am. K-3 lunch begins at 11:40 am. Grades 4-8 lunch begins at 12:15 pm. On Tuesdays, K-8 eat together in family groups at 12:15 pm.

Our lunch menu is on a four week rotation. Lunch consists of a hot entree, fruit choice, and vegetable choice with one carton of milk. Students may order a sandwich lunch instead of hot lunch, which consists of a sandwich (on a weekly rotating schedule), fruit choice, vegetable choice, and a carton of milk.

Students may also bring lunch from home. For students bringing lunch from home, a carton of milk will cost \$0.60 per carton.

Any additional cartons of milk with a school lunch (hot lunch or sandwich) will cost \$0.60 per carton. Please discuss with your child whether they are allowed to take extra milk.

PAYMENTS for MILK

If applicable, payments for milk to student meal accounts can be made by cash or check (made out to ISD 197 Child Nutrition with your child's name in the memo line) to the black mailbox in the front hallway, or online through MyPaymentsPlus. Contact the district office for your child's ID number.

IMPORTANT: The TLO School Meal program begins Tuesday, September 3rd.
